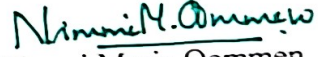

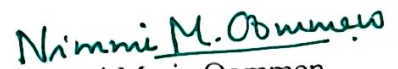

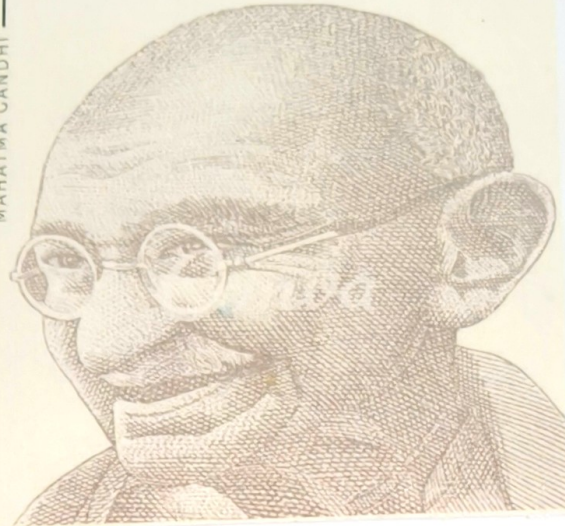

The winners of the quiz competition are:

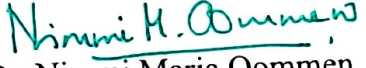

Thiruvalla**

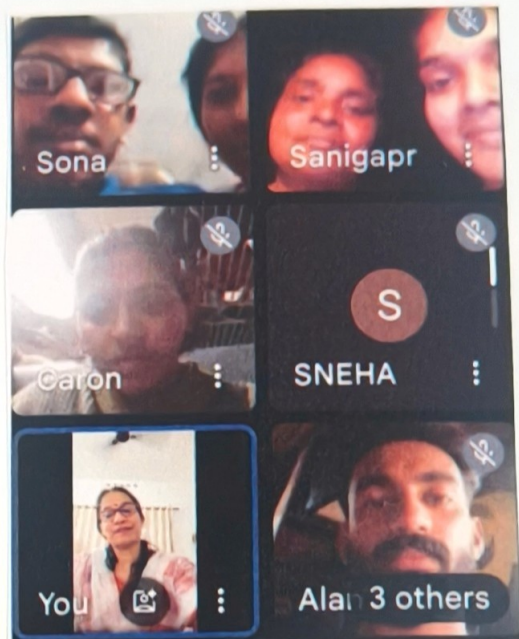
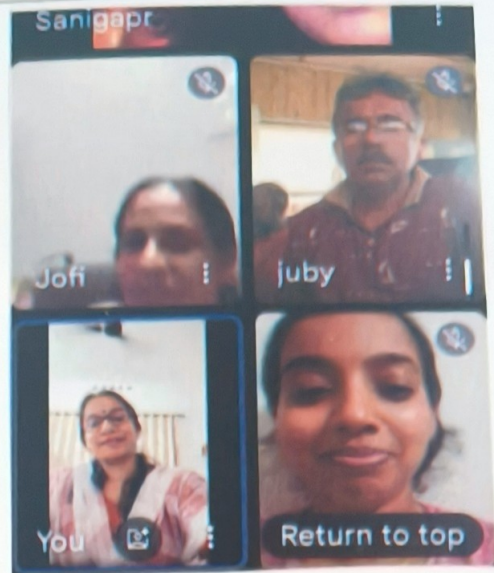
